## *Board Member Responsibilities:*

- ◆ As a board member, you will help provide high-level governance, long-term strategic planning, fiscal oversight, and direction for the Executive Director.
- ◆ Meetings are held the third Thursday of each month at 8:00 a.m. Term is two, three-year terms, for a total of six years, followed by a year off.
- ◆ Board committees include: Strategic, Finance, Donor Relations, Membership. Board members are expected to join a committee within three months of joining the Board of Directors.
- ◆ *Next steps: 1) Introductory meeting with the Executive Director; 2) Review Ember Center's annual financial audit and other documents; 3) Complete a board member application; 4) Interview with the Membership Committee; 5) Board vote for membership upon recommendation of the Membership Committee.*

Centrally located in the Inverness development and serving the south Denver Metro area, Ember Center provides free and confidential programs and services for adults and children who have been impacted by domestic violence and sexual assault. Services include emergency shelter, therapy, legal advocacy, community-based advocacy, as well as education and outreach.
